<b>Overview of Event</b>	<p><b>GPCARE (General Practitioners' Consortium Arrangement Rochdale East) was formed in June 2006; they held this event to share the journey and achievements to date as well as sharing the vision for the future.</b></p> <p><b>They have introduced one stop shops which enables reviews of all patients with complex care needs to enable the patient to be seen on the same day for more than one illness. Investment into clinical treatment rooms to provide future services in the community. An extended minor surgery service has been set up this is delivered across Rochdale, Littleborough and Milnrow. A scriptswitch software system has been installed, along with image capture cameras.</b></p> <p><b>They are currently working on a three year business plan in partnership with HMR. Their aspirations are to become a World Class Commissioning PBC (Practice Based Commissioning)/Integrated Care Organisation. They want to establish links with Social Care and the Local Authority.</b></p> <p><b>The vision is to lead the redesign of services and clinical pathways in primary care/secondary care. Ensure that services are safe, effective and as efficient as possible and that financial efficiencies realised are reinvested back into the local health community. Create a powerful voice for the development of patient centred services with local stakeholders within the local health economy.</b></p> <p><b>The event was attended by the staff from practices across the East PBC area.</b></p>

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
